

- B. Approval of minutes of the previous meeting(s): After review, motion to approve the minutes from the October 19 meeting was made by Hall and seconded by Coyle. It was the consensus of the council to approve the minutes.
- C. Good News Report: Mr. Noble informed the council that visitors in the building including Katrina Slone and Kim Cornett had given positive reports of the programs and procedures being implemented.
